NOUN

Let us learn about NOUN.

What is called noun?

- **❖** Noun is a naming word.
- Noun refers to the name of a person, place, animal or a thing.
- ❖ For E.g:
 - 1. I love chocolates.

In this sentence the word chocolate is a noun.

2. Mumbai is a big city.

In this sentence, the words city and Mumbai are nouns.

Children, do u know that the nouns can be divided into common nouns and proper nouns?

NOUN COMMON NOUN PROPER NOUN

COMMON NOUN:

- Common noun refers to the common name of a person, place or thing.
- ❖ Like the words school, dog, tree, book and boy, all these words are common noun.
- ❖ For e.g:
 - 1. Children love sweets.
 - 2. I am going to school.

In these above sentences, the words children, sweets and school are common nouns.

PROPER NOUN:

- Proper noun refers to the particular name of a person, place or a thing.
- Always remember that a proper noun always begins with a CAPITAL LETTER.
- Like the words James, Mumbai, December and Barh.

- **❖** For eg:
 - 1. Tom likes toys.
 - 2. Jenny is a good girl.
 - 3. India is my country.
 - 4. I went to Patna.
 - 5. We go to temple on Friday.

These highlighted words are proper nouns.

Let's notice the difference in the below table:

Common Noun	Proper Noun
boy	Ayush
shop	Puja Textiles
river	Ganga
country	India
school	Notre Dame Academy
