	No overloading — each student must have a proper seat. [ number of children ≤ approved seating]
	♦ Children should be picked up/dropped only at safe and designated points inside the township.
	[dropped before 5 min of student reporting time & picked up within 10 min after dismissal]
	$\checkmark$ Autos and e-rickshaws are banned for transporting school children.
	✓ If you are coming to school with bike, parent and student both must wear helmet.
2.	Rules for Students
	Students must also follow safety habits.
	They should:
	☐ Be ready on time — avoid rushing to the vehicle.
	☐ Sit properly, not stand or lean out of windows.
	☐ Avoid shouting, distracting the driver, or playing inside the vehicle.
	☐ Follow road safety rules while walking to or from the vehicle.
	☐ Report any unsafe driving or misbehavior immediately to parents.
3.	Rules for Vehicle Drivers
	Drivers operating within NTPC Township must strictly follow RTO and township norms.
	They must:
	☐ Have a valid <b>driving license</b> , <b>permit</b> , and <b>pollution certificate (PUC)</b> .
	☐ Display "School Vehicle" & "On School Duty" signage.

	☐ Undergo verification (as required by local administration or NTPC security).
	□ Not carry more than the allowed number of students (no overloading).
	☐ Ensure <b>doors are locked</b> while moving, and students board safely at stops.
	☐ Use <b>speed governors</b> — not exceed <b>40 km/h</b> inside the township.
	☐ Keep first-aid kit, fire extinguisher, and emergency contact list inside.
	□ Avoid loud music or mobile phone use while driving.
	☐ Follow NTPC township traffic regulations and security gate entry norms.
